### *Strategic Training for TB Elimination, New Delhi*

August 8th, 2024: GLRA India organizes a training session for its field staff under the projects "It's a FIGHTbACK" and "Nai DISHA" at The Union South East Asia Office, New Delhi, led by Dr. Midhun Rajiv and Dr. Nikita Srivastava.

#### Key Outcomes:

- Formation of a dedicated community task force to create a sustainable TB elimination system.
- Involvement of school students in TB prevention through targeted awareness programs on essential health practices.



### *Active Case Finding to Combat Tuberculosis, Gurugram, Haryana*

A community-led Active TB finding drive has been launched in Gurugram, a suburb next to the Indian capital. These collaborative efforts also disseminate the government policies on TB prevention including free testing, diagnosis, treatment, and follow-up.

### *KAP Survey on Sanitation & Hygiene, Agra, Uttar Pradesh*



GLRA has organized a week long survey to assess the KAPs (Knowledge, Attitudes, and Practices) on sanitation and hygiene among 6,000 slum households in Agra is expected to bring light on their current practices and traditional behaviors. The survey aims to enhance community ownership through 25 volunteers to sensitize 28,000 residents on clean living conditions, and healthier habits and reduce disease prevalence



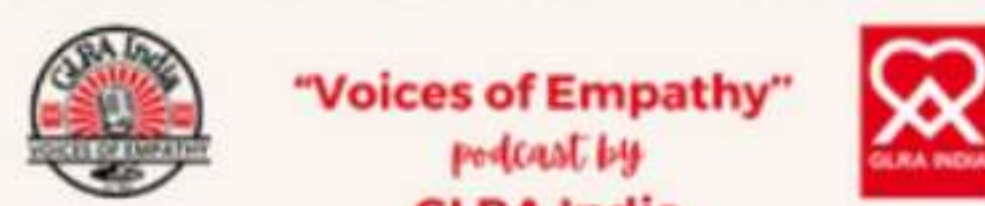
